



Using cameras and sensors, they can help provide greater peace of mind amidst the challenges of everyday driving — along with available convenience features such as Surround View Monitor,²⁰ which provides a bird's-eye view around the vehicle, and Remote Smart Parking Assist 2,^{22*} which lets you remotely command your EV9 to pull in or out of some tight parking spaces.

EV9 features Highway Driving Assist 2²³ and Navigation-based Smart Cruise Control — Curve²⁴, which are designed to assist in maintaining a set distance from the vehicle in front, and even help adjust to upcoming curves detected on certain federal highways.

Lane Assist features^{20*}

Lane Following Assist 2²⁰ Lane Keeping Assist²⁰ Lane Change — Oncoming^{20*} These are just some of the EV9's automatic steering-assistance technologies designed to help keep you centered within detected lane markers, help prevent drifting, and help avoid collisions with oncoming vehicles when changing lanes under certain conditions.

Environmental Monitoring features

Standard advanced features monitor the environment inside and outside EV9's cabin to help enhance safety. These include Driver Attention Warning²⁵ which is designed to help keep the driver alert by giving a warning if the system detects driver inattention; Intelligent Speed Limit Assist²⁶ which is designed to detect the speed limit on certain roads, and warn the driver if the vehicle exceeds the limit; and High Beam Assist²⁷ which is designed to automatically adjust the high beams for oncoming vehicles.

Blind-Spot Collision-Avoidance features²⁰
